Either. There are two main ways to join plastic pipe and fittings like PVC and CPVC - cement socket welding and threaded end connections. Threaded connections sometimes get a bad rap for being leaky and weaker than standard socket connections. This means either fitting a connector to its end, or connecting it directly to another fiber, known as splicing. If a connector is used, the two fibers can later be disconnected for testing or to change the routing. I have a question, Is threading electrical PVC conduit (Sch 40 and/or Sch 80) in the field an approved/listed means for construction? I personally have never seen this done in the field, nor would I thread PVC in the field.
