

What is a long-span cable tray structure

Article Overview

A long-span cable tray is a support system designed to carry electrical and data cables over extended distances between supports, typically 6-18 meters, while handling heavy loads efficiently.

Definition and Structure

A long-span cable tray is engineered to span large distances without frequent support points, unlike standard trays that require supports every 1.5-3 meters. It features reinforced side rails and either ladder-style rungs or solid/perforated bases, depending on the type of cables and environmental conditions . Ladder trays are lightweight and allow heat dissipation, making them suitable for power cables, while solid or perforated trays provide full protection for sensitive data cables and heavy loads .

Advantages

- o Fewer supports: Reduces the number of brackets, hangers, and concrete bases by 30-50%, saving material and installation time .
- o Clear floor space: Minimizes trip hazards and avoids column obstructions .
- o Easier maintenance: Open designs allow easy access for inspection and cable management .
- o High load capacity: Can carry thick power cables, data lines, and HVAC wiring together, often with a 20% safety margin .
- o Durability: Constructed from galvanized steel, aluminum, or powder-coated materials to withstand indoor and outdoor conditions .

Applications

Long-span cable trays are ideal for industrial facilities, high-bay warehouses, stadiums, bridges, and underground projects such as subways or civil defense installations . They are particularly useful where support points are limited or where large cable loads need to be routed efficiently over long distances.

Installation Considerations

- o Span length: Typically 6-18 meters between supports, with sag limited to $\text{span length} / 200$.
 - o Load handling: Must support the total cable weight plus a safety margin, often around 150 kg/m .
 - o Prestressing: Some systems use tensioning devices to offset stress and reduce deflection, improving structural stability .
 - o Certification: For public buildings, compliance with standards like BS EN 61537 is recommended .
- Long-span cable trays provide a cost-effective, durable, and efficient solution for routing large volumes of cables over extended distances while maintaining accessibility and safety.
