A pigtail fiber indicates a short length of optical fiber cable that has a pigtail connector (for example, SC, FC, ST, LC, etc.) fitted on one end and the other end undressed (for connection through fusion or splicing) to the main fiber optic cable. Mixing them up drives costs higher, increases loss, and slows your rollout. Pigtails are widely used in RF, fiber.
