Light is often transmitted using LEDs, and multimode fibers are more cost-effective for shorter distances .

Cable Construction

Fiber optic cables consist of several layers to ensure durability and signal integrity:

- o **Core:** The central glass or plastic strand that carries light signals.
- o **Cladding:** Surrounds the core with a lower refractive index to maintain total internal reflection, keeping light within the core.
- o **Buffer Coating:** A protective plastic layer that shields the fiber from physical damage.
- o **Outer Sheath:** Additional protective layers depending on environmental requirements, such as indoor, outdoor, or armored cables .

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Specialized Fiber Types

- o Armored Fiber Cables: Include a protective metal layer for harsh environments.
- o Ribbon Fiber Cables: Contain multiple fibers in a flat ribbon for high-density applications.
- o Plastic Optical Fiber (POF): Used for short-distance, low-cost applications like consumer electronics .
