- o **Aluminum Trays:** Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and easy to install, making them ideal for general-purpose and low-load applications .
- o **Fiberglass Trays:** Resistant to corrosion and chemicals, suitable for offshore or highly corrosive environments .
- o **Non-Metallic Options:** Include specialized plastics or composites for lightweight or electrically insulated applications .

- o **Center Suspensions:** Used to support long spans of cable trays at intermediate points to prevent sagging .
- o **Mounting Plates and Accessories:** Facilitate attachment of junction boxes, devices, or additional fittings to the tray system .
