

What types of switches should I buy for the distribution box

Main Switches

The main switch disconnects the distribution box from the incoming power supply. In small residential boards, this is often a double-pole switch, while in three-phase systems, it may be a four-pole switch disconnector or a main MCCB. Main switches provide isolation but may not offer overcurrent protection unless specifically rated for it .

Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs)

MCBs protect outgoing circuits from overloads and short circuits. Each circuit is matched to the conductor size, load type, and installation method. MCBs do not provide residual-current protection, so they are often paired with RCDs or RCBOs for enhanced safety .

Residual Current Devices (RCDs), RCCBs, and RCBOs

These devices detect current imbalances between live and neutral conductors to prevent electric shocks and reduce fire risk from earth leakage. RCCBs or RCDs provide residual-current protection, while RCBOs combine overcurrent and residual-current protection in a single device .

Isolators

Isolators are manually operated switches used to safely disconnect a part of the circuit for maintenance. They ensure that sections of the electrical system can be worked on without risk of electric shock .

Transfer Switches

Transfer switches are used in critical facilities to switch between primary and backup power sources. They can be manual or automatic (ATS), allowing seamless power transfer without interrupting the load .

Smart and Advanced Switches

Modern distribution boxes may include smart circuit breakers and switches with energy monitoring, remote control, or integration with home automation systems. These devices enhance safety, energy management, and

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operational efficiency .
