Bundling Cables Together: Use cable ties to bundle fiber optic cables, which prevents tangling and makes it easier to identify and maintain them. Be sure to tie the cable ties loosely to avoid applying pressure to the cable. This includes pulling tension, minimum bend radius and crush loads.
