Optical fiber consists of a core and a cladding layer, selected for due to the difference in the refractive index between the two. In practical fibers, the cladding is usually coated with a layer of buffer coating. This coating protects the fiber from damage but does not contribute to its optical properties. Individual coated fibers (or fibers formed into ribbons or bundles) then have a protective jacket.

Most systems use a "transceiver" which includes both transmission and receiver in a single module. The transmitter takes an electrical input and converts it to an optical signal.
