

Wiring Installation in Home Electrical Distribution Boxes

- o Properly ground the distribution box and all metal parts to prevent electric shock.
- o Ensure the grounding wire is connected to a reliable earth point ().

Step 7: Testing and Verification

- o Perform an insulation resistance test using a qualified tester to verify insulation quality.
- o Use a multimeter to check each circuit for continuity and correct on/off operation.
- o Verify that there are no short circuits or loose connections before powering on ().

Step 8: Labeling and Maintenance

- o Label each circuit clearly for easy identification and future troubleshooting.
- o Schedule regular inspections to ensure long-term reliability and safety.
