Overview of a Distribution Box

A distribution box (also called a fuse board, panel board, or consumer unit) is designed to safely distribute electricity from the main supply to various circuits in a home. It typically contains:

- o Main switch or Main MCB: Controls the overall power supply to the house. Often a double-pole MCB rated at 63A for single-phase domestic installations .
- o RCCB/RCD (Residual Current Device): Provides protection against electric shock, leakage currents, and insulation faults. Commonly rated at 30mA for domestic use .
- o Single-pole MCBs: Protect individual circuits such as lighting, fans, and sockets .
- o Neutral and Earth links: Distribute neutral and earth connections to all circuits .

Typical Wiring Connections

- o Incoming Supply: The live (phase) and neutral wires from the utility meter enter the main MCB.
- o Main MCB to RCD: The output of the main MCB connects to the input of the RCD.
- o RCD to Circuit MCBs: The RCD output feeds the individual single-pole MCBs for lighting, power sockets, and appliances.
- o Neutral and Earth Distribution: Neutral wires from all circuits connect to the neutral busbar, and all earth wires connect to the earth busbar, which is linked to the grounding electrode .
- o Color Coding: Standard color codes are used--live (red or brown), neutral (black or blue), and earth (green/yellow) for safety and compliance .

Types of Household Wiring Diagrams

- o Single-phase distribution box: Shows connections for a 230V supply with main MCB, RCD, and multiple output MCBs .
- o Light and switch circuits: Diagrams include single-pole switches, 3-way and 4-way switches, dimmers, and combo devices .
- o Receptacle wiring: Covers duplex outlets, GFCI outlets, and higher-rated sockets (15A, 20A, 30A, 50A) with proper neutral and earth connections .
- o Fan/light kits and bathroom exhaust fans: Illustrates wiring for combined or separate controls, timers, and GFCI protection .
- o Basic house wiring: Integrates main switch, MCB/fuse, sockets, lights, and earthing for safe and efficient
