

Wiring diagram of distribution box components

Article Overview

A distribution box wiring diagram shows how the main breaker, MCBs, RCCBs, neutral and ground bars, and branch circuits are interconnected to safely distribute electricity.

Key Components and Their Wiring

1. **Main Breaker (Main MCB):** The main breaker receives the incoming power supply (phase and neutral) and controls the overall electricity flow to the distribution box. In single-phase systems, a double-pole MCB is typically used as the main switch, rated around 63A for domestic installations. The input wires from the service line connect directly to the main breaker . 2. **Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB):** RCCBs protect against leakage currents and electric shocks. The output from the main breaker is connected to the input of the RCCB. Its output then feeds the individual MCBs. A 30mA RCCB is commonly used in single-phase domestic setups . 3. **Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs):** MCBs protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits. Single-pole MCBs are used for standard loads like lighting and outlets, while double-pole MCBs may be used for high-power appliances. Each MCB receives power from the RCCB output and distributes it to its respective circuit . 4. **Neutral Bar:** The neutral bar distributes the neutral wire to all output circuits. Each load's neutral wire connects to this bar, ensuring a return path for current. The neutral bar is also connected to the incoming neutral from the main supply . 5. **Earth/Ground Bar:** The earth bar connects all grounding wires from the circuits and the incoming supply. Proper grounding is essential for safety, preventing electric shocks and equipment damage .

Wiring Layout Overview

- o Incoming phase and neutral -> Main MCB
- o Main MCB output -> RCCB input
- o RCCB output -> Individual MCBs
- o MCB outputs -> Branch circuits (lights, outlets, appliances)
- o Neutral wires -> Neutral bar
- o Earth wires -> Earth bar

Safety Considerations

- o Always turn off the main power supply before working on the distribution box .
- o Ensure correct wire sizing according to the load and breaker rating.
- o Label all circuits clearly for easy identification and emergency shutdown.
- o Verify proper grounding to prevent electric shock.
