

Wiring of air switch distribution box

Article Overview

Air switches in a distribution box should be wired with proper phase, neutral, and earth connections, using correctly rated switches for each circuit and organized wiring for safety and efficiency.

Selection of Air Switches

- o Main switch: Typically a double-pole 32-63A air switch or isolation switch for the household supply .
- o Lighting circuits: Use 10-16A air switches .
- o Socket circuits: Use 16-20A air switches; high-power appliances may require 20A .
- o Air conditioning circuits: Use 16-25A air switches .
- o Three-phase circuits: Ensure the incoming line matches the switch type; connect phase, neutral, and earth appropriately .

Wiring Procedure

- o Preparation: Ensure the distribution box is installed, clean, and ventilated. Prepare wiring conductors, ties, and switches according to design drawings .
- o Guide rail installation: Install guide rails horizontally to align with the cover's operation holes .
- o Switch placement: Arrange switches from left to right, reserving space for main and branch air switches. Typically, the reserved space is on the right side of the box .
- o Phase and neutral wiring:
 - o Phase wires (live) connect to the input terminal of each air switch.
 - o Neutral wires (blue) connect to the neutral terminal; do not share neutral wires across different phases .
- o Lighting and socket circuits generally use 2.5mm² wires; air conditioning circuits may use 2.5-4.0mm² wires .
- o Earth connection: Connect the protective earth wire to the distribution box or appliance grounding points.
- o Wire routing: Wiring between the main switch and branch switches usually goes on the left; outgoing lines to circuits go on the right. Keep wires straight, free of wrinkles, and tie them with plastic ties at uniform spacing .
- o Circuit labeling: Mark each circuit clearly for identification .
- o Safety check: After wiring, inspect for short circuits, loose connections, or overload risks .

Additional Tips

- o Ensure incoming wires are long enough to avoid joints inside the box .
- o Maintain consistent wire bending without sharp angles to prevent insulation damage .
- o Keep the distribution box at an accessible height (around 1.8 meters) for safe operation . Following these steps ensures that the air switch wiring is safe, organized, and compliant with standard household electrical

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practices.
