o Wiring Outgoing Circuits

- o Route wires neatly within the enclosure, using cable ties to prevent tangling.
- o Connect line to line, neutral to neutral, and ground to ground, following the wiring diagram.

 - o Reconnect the main power and test each circuit individually to ensure proper operation.
